American Literature Apostles of Liberty Essay Questions

Directions: Each group member must choose a different one of the following writing assignments concerned with issues raised in Chapter 1: *Apostles of Liberty*.

- 1. Identify three facets of the concept of religious freedom that this story addresses. In a personal essay, explain why these particular aspects are interesting to you.
- 2. In a one-page essay, compare and contrast the teachings and practices of the Anglican Church and the Separate Baptists in colonial Virginia.
- 3. Imagine that you are John Waller. Compose a "Letter from the Spotsylvania County jail," in which you appeal to leaders of all faiths to support religious liberty. Post your letter, and those of your classmates, on a classroom bulletin board. Discuss observations with the class. As an extension, read "Letter from a Birmingham Jail" by Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and write a personal response.
- 4. Dr. King once said, "The church must be reminded that it is not the master or the servant of the state, but rather the conscience of the state." Write a broadside (single-sheet newspaper) editorial either opposing or supporting this statement.
- 5. Rewrite this story in the form of a poem, song or rap. What title will you choose? What are your main themes? What is the refrain? Share your creation with the class.
