- 4. What details in the second paragraph develop Silko's observation from the first sentence of the essay?
- 5. How does Silko's description of the views of the "[y]ounger people" and "the oldtime people" (par. 3) further develop the situation she describes in paragraph 2?
- 6. What does Silko mean when she writes "[m]any worlds may coexist here" (par. 3)?
