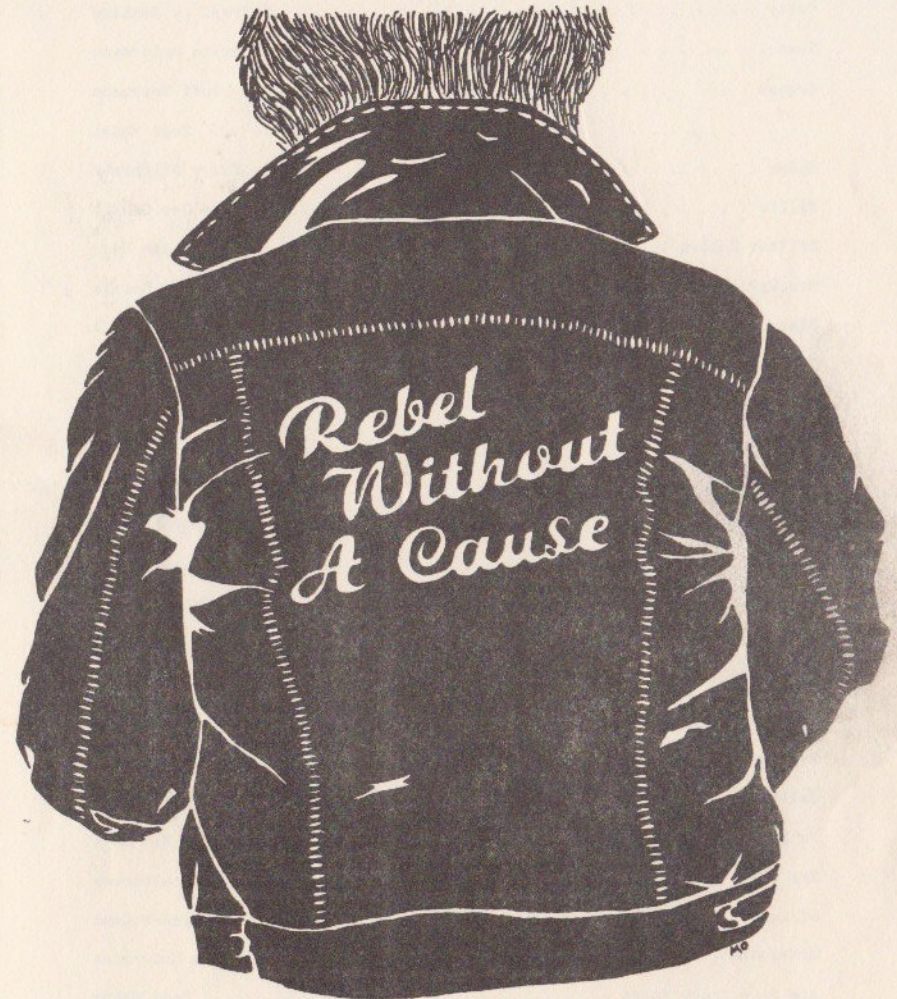
Camp YTU -
